Mission - local and abroad

Every expression of church life should reflect those five values. For that reason, your leaders are engaged in fresh conversations as to how to work these values through each site, department and ministry.

2. Simplify for strength We have spent a lot of time working at getting "clutter" out of church life and programs. It is our earnest desire to be fruitful, rather than just busy. We are believing to go from strength to strength, with signs of health across all aspects of church life; where people genuinely love God, each other and a world that Jesus died for.

3. Purify for power God is at work. There is a fresh wave of grace across the church, which is building to a fresh surge of Kingdom life amongst us. In amongst that, there is a call to prayer, to holy living and to healthy relationships with one another. It's really not complicated.

The prophet Micah captured so wonderfully what the Lord is saying and doing amongst us, when he wrote, "But he's already made it plain how to live, what to do, what God is looking for in men and women. It's quite simple: Do what is fair and just to your neighbour, be compassionate and loyal in your love, and don't take yourself too seriously - take God seriously." (Micah 6:8 MSG)

So let's together, keep loving God, loving people and loving life.
