WHERE Assam - Northeastern state of India, capital city; Guwahati

WHO Assamese People Cluster (Hindu, Muslim, Buddhist & Sikh);
23 People groups – of whom 19 are considered to be “least reached peoples**”

POPULATION 25 million people, less than 1% of the population are Christians

GOALS A movement of 300 Church planters trained and mobilised into unreached cities and villages

Train and Inspire a younger generation to reach their neighbors and plant community transforming churches

To recruit and train indigenous leaders from the 23 Tribal groups around Assam

To model HOPE as a means of community transformation and church planting around the world

To demonstrate and share the HOPE model with other existing church movements around the world

HOW Conducting and sponsoring training for 300 Assamese Christians in North East India, where they will learn the framework and methodologies of HOPE and link with strong mentors from our global HOPE network

Strategic partnership with HOPE trainees linking City Church people with communities

Seed project grants and mentoring through our global HOPE network
